Ohio FBINAA Members,

At the Annual Business Meeting, the membership will be considering and voting on a proposed change to the Ohio Chapter Constitution. The following is the current and proposed language.

Current Language

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS

Section 7

While serving as a Board Member the individual must maintain all the membership requirements listed above. They also must maintain full time law enforcement status for the first two years on the Board, afterward they may be fully retired but may not be employed in any other employment or profession that is not compatible with the principles and purposes of this Association. Each elected member of the Executive Board shall reside within the State of Ohio. A Board member who leaves law enforcement within the first two (2) years has 120 days to continue full time law enforcement employment or resign from the Board. They have the right to appeal to the Executive Board for reinstatement.

Proposed Language

While serving as a Board Member the individual must maintain all the membership requirements listed above. Board members may be fully retired but may not be employed in any other employment or profession that is not compatible with the principles and purposes of this Association. Each elected member of the Executive Board shall reside within the State of Ohio.

Summary of Changes

Under the current Constitution, individuals seeking to join the Executive Board must be currently employed in a fulltime capacity and maintain that status for their first two years on the board. The proposed language eliminates the requirement of fulltime law enforcement

status and replaces it with a common eligibility standard for all Chapter members, retired or active, who are in good standing and wish to serve on the Executive Board.
